Who

Anyone who has a heart for homeless families: individuals, families, youth groups, etc. Youth under the age of 18 must have a chaperone that is over age 21.

What

Each participant raises at least \$100 in contributions and sleeps overnight in a cardboard box "home" as a resident of our Box City in order to raise awareness of homeless families in our community. There will be activities, entertainment, and food for participants.

"Virtual" residents can participate as well – raise \$100, enjoy the evening activities, leave at 10 pm and sleep at home.

There is also a \$20 registration fee for all participants.
