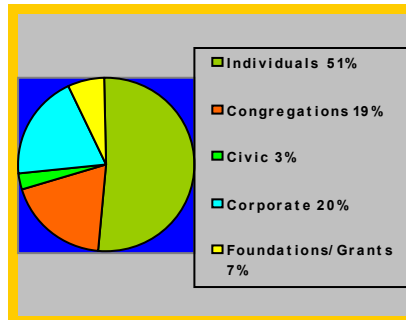
- 5,840 nights of shelter provided.
- 17,520 meals were provided.
- Sixteen families comprised of 16 adults and 27 children were served.
- Fifteen families successfully exited the program into permanent housing. ( 93% )
- Four families are currently under case management and receiving services.
- Three families are currently in our aftercare program. They receive limited services and are currently self sufficient.
- The average age of a child in our program was 9.6 years old.
- Average length of stay was 82.5 days in emergency shelter.
- Through a partnership with City Rescue Mission we have more than doubled the capacity of our program. ( 9 families )
- 347 families were screened for placement in the program. ( 48% were eligible, but space was not available in order to place them. )
- Our transitional housing program, "FastForward" has been very successful with a 99% success rate.
- 753 volunteers provided 15,623 hours of service to our homeless families.
- 421 individuals were provided indirect services. ( food, clothing, house wares, bus tickets, etc. )
- Since 2006 80 families have received direct services. These families were comprised of 241 individuals.
- Since 2006 we have provided 151 individuals post care services.

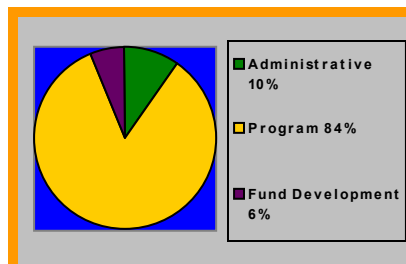
